Final Practice

****NEW THIS YEAR**** We are not having a full dress rehearsal this year. We are going to give each group 10 minutes for a final practice. We are asking that skaters are at the Huck Olson Arena on Friday March 19th in costume with skates on 15 minutes before their scheduled time. Please see below for your scheduled time.

****Parent helpers will meet skaters in the locker rooms, bring them to the ice & back to the locker room where you should pick them up right after they are done skating. This is to allow parents the option of watching their skater from the stands.

Ice Show Instruction

The Ice Show is at the Ralph Engelstad Arena on Saturday, March 20th at 6:00 p.m. and Sunday, March 21st at 2:00 p.m. Skaters should be there **thirty** minutes before the show starts. Please come dressed in costume. There may be parts of the costume to be handed out just before the show and returned to the parent helper afterwards. If possible, apply some lipstick, blush and eye shadow at home. Skaters will come on the ice through the zam end. Parents and other people **may not be in the player's boxes** during the ice show.

Finale

The finale is at the end of each show when all skaters come out. We will not have a finale practice. Solos and features will be introduced first. All skaters are to skate with their group. Please inform your child that he/she will be asked to leave the ice if they do not comply with the finale rules. No fast skating or horseplay will be allowed! **Parents please keep skaters off the ice until told to come onto the ice for the finale. A suggestion to the parents would be that one parent watches the finale Saturday and the other Sunday.**

Sunday

Costumes are worn for pictures, dress rehearsals and shows only. Costumes are the property of the Skating Club and, if furnished for you, **costumes must be checked in following the Sunday performance.** Please do not use pins on costumes as this can tear the material (use hooks and eyes or Velcro). **Bring clothes for your child to go home in.** Costumes must be turned in with the skaters' name on each bag so if we need to repair or replace costumes we will know whom to bill. **Costumes not turned in or damaged must be paid for.** NO pom-poms are allowed on skates. Skates should be polished and laces cleaned.

Have your skater's name on the bag/box when it is turned in to avoid being charged for a costume.

- Concessions, programs, and flowers purchased at the arena help to defray our program costs.

Family Tickets

Family tickets will be sold during Final Practice at \$7.00 each. Family tickets will allow mom, dad, brothers and sisters still at home to attend both shows. Also during final practice there will be, for your convenience, advanced tickets for sale to let aunts, uncles, grandparents' etc. attend. Prices are as follows: Adults:

All Tickets will be \$1.00 more per ticket at the door.

- ✓ All persons going to the ice show need tickets even if you are working most of each performance. Advanced tickets may be purchased for friends and relatives but only immediate family of skaters may use the family tickets.

PARENT JOBS

Tickets, Flowers, Programs, Raffle: Need to be at the arena 1 hour before show time. We ask that ticket sellers stay at their spots until 6-7 routines into the show. Flowers, Programs, & Raffle are sold until the end of the show.

Concessions: 1st half workers need to be at the concession stand 45 minutes before the show starts. 2nd half workers are asked to be at the concession stand before the intermission.

Lights: Need to be at the arena 30 minutes before show time

Parent Helpers: We ask that the parent helper is in the assigned locker room 4 groups before you go on the ice. Make sure you have all the skaters & help them to the ice. Stay with them until they go on the ice & come off, walk them back to the locker room & wait for a parent to come & get them.
